O has 1 litterbox for 3 cats, is packing her house for remodeling, and has another cat at home who is not doing well. P has been urinating on the furniture and new pillows for the past 3 weeks, still defecates in the litterbox. Went into detail on adding more litterboxes, adding Feliway, giving P her own space in order to enrich environment. O brought up possibility of rehoming P, I said that environmental enrichment would be first step into seeing if this can be fixed. O understands. Kept P, able to get urine via free catch. Moderate RBCs and WBCs seen with occasional cocci, few struvites. Will rec continued gabapentin, O can swing P by for a convenia inj tomorrow.

There is no record of a PLO given or prescribed. o thinks that she is having allergies currently, doesn't feel that it's an infection, she is now going outside which makes her congestion worse. Recommended that she come in. Discussed that PLO gels are ineffective in cats, discussed that I am not optimistic that she would benefit from a PLO of cyproheptadine, and they may remember that she improved because the URI resolved. o reports that she cannot medicate her, but elects to try 14 mg benadryl (discussed that this is more than a tsp) first.
